Association Reports:	 L. Goodman - Firefly CAPS – Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Services: FIREFLY is now offering this service that is for children and youth with severe mental health concerns. FIREFLY has hired a Registered nurse and social worker to help implement the program in conjunction with psychiatrist, Dr. Crookall. Clients must be or become a patient of Dr. Crookall. Coconut – online booking platform: Allows for a more client-based and consistent approach to booking appointments. Allows for external access by clients from links. Some programs are now offering self-registration through Coconut, such as FIREFLY's Supporting Your Picky Eater Presentation. Allows for virtual appointment reminders to be sent to clients. Ocean – platform used to electronically send and receive referrals between agencies. Members of Ocean can be senders or receivers – FIREFLY is both. The hope is for all school boards to sign up for Ocean (free) as senders. This allows the school boards to access the FIREFLY General Referral Form and all screeners. Using Ocean to refer clients/students to FIREFLY ensures: that the most up to date referral forms are being used by the school the referral process is streamlined
