Special Education Lead Update J. Bachynski	Our schools are continuing to hold case conferences with parents/guardians, community supports and services and school teams to ensure our students experience a successful transition and ensure that goals and next steps are in place. The window for EQAO for grade 3 and 6 students, opened May 4th and closes June 24th. All students are now able to access accommodations without an IEP which include: additional time, a quiet setting, prompts, supervised breaks, verbatim reading of instructions and/or questions by an education or scribe for writing and math, a text-to-speech tool is built into the e-assessment	



	system for all students to utilize, for open-response language questions a paper or an online response format is allowed.	
	May is Speech and Hearing Month, our Speech Language Pathologists have a created an interactive poster with excellent and valuable resources such as how to create a listening friendly class, there is also information on speech and language disorders and some information about the KPDSB Facebook page which includes videos around Speech and Language.	
	As a SEL team we are finalizing paperwork around the IPRC process, we are also collaborating with the Literacy Special Assignment Teachers to help support our schools with evidence-based Literacy programs backed by the Science of Reading, which include Heggerty and Bridge the Gap.	
	We have held two exciting and engaging sessions with Shelley Moore for our Special Education Resource Teachers and administrators around Transforming Inclusive Education and Designing for Diversity to move our work towards building effective practices of inclusion through a strength-based approach.

They are in Kenora, Sioux Lookout and Fort Frances and are 1 month into their programming. We have 3 new families who have received invites who we will begin planning for their program delivery. Urgent Response service (OAP) is launched and accepting referrals Dietician will begin next week: to expand our abilities to best support clients with complex feeding problems and support clients with eating disorders. Smart Start is starting to meet with partners this month. All documents and training was completed in phase 1 of implementation Circles of Security: Infant Child Development and psychology intern offered this program virtually with great attendance and participation for 5 families. Triple P program undergoing accreditation with plan to begin offering programming fall 2022.
