They are finishing up reports for the year so post meetings can be held and reports can be mailed out before the end of June. We are ensuring all IPRCs or waivers are completed. The end of year IEP processes are a focus at this time. We are in the process of recruiting an SLP. We have had three engaging sessions on Inclusive Education. We have partnered with George Jeffrey Children's Centre again this summer to offer evidenced- based virtual social skills programs for students with the diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). The programs being offered include <i>Time for a Playdate</i> ® (4 to 7 year olds) and <i>Confidence and Bullying</i> ® (8 - 12 years old and 13 to 17 years old).
