Dear KPDSB Families,

Our staff have been busy this week adjusting to the new circumstances many of us in Ontario are finding ourselves in as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. We've also been planning and preparing to support our students and families in new ways and look forward to sharing more information on this in the coming week.

We know that many families have questions about their child's education and how school closures will impact their year. We are working to ensure that students will be able to continue their coursework and credit accumulation in different ways, knowing that some students have access to online supports and that we will need to provide supports differently for those who do not. Minister Lecce has said, "We want to make this clear: no graduating student will have their ability to graduate impacted by the two-week closure and the COVID19 developments." Please be assured that we will continue to share information with families as often as possible and that we are here to support you and your child(ren) during this time.

Below are some updates from this week that we thought may be helpful to share with families.

- We know that many families are wondering about school closures being extended past April 5, 2020. As soon as we receive official word on expectations for the length of school closures, we will be sure to share that information with you. We anticipate information next week from the Chief Medical Officer of Health and the Ministry of Education.
- Staff in our schools and programs began reaching out to families this week to check-in, reconnect, and ask families for some specific information around what you may need from us to support learning at home during the closures. If you have not yet been contacted, you will be very soon.
