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Policy Name: **School Improvement Planning**

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Policy Statement

It is the policy of the Keewatin-Patricia District School Board (KPDSB) that each school shall develop a plan for school improvement. The KPDSB is committed to school improvement planning process which reflect the priorities in the KPDSB's Strategic Improvement Plan.

School improvement plans should ensure the necessary resources are provided to all students to increase their individual achievement and identify the professional development required by staff to support student academic success, well-being, and engagement in learning. School improvement plans should identify actions that are required for all students to feel safe, supported, accepted, and ready to learn. School improvement plans should be informed by data, supported by research, and set high standards for all students. Goals identified within school improvement plans should encourage innovation and be monitored throughout the course of the school year to determine ongoing next steps,

Rationale

School improvement plans will foster continuous improvement of instruction, the learning environment, and meaningful involvement of members of the educational community through actions which are deliberate, diligently implemented, supportively monitored, and continuously evaluated, including collection and analysis of data.
