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## 2018 Summer Learning Programs

The Keewatin-Patricia District School Board is once again offering Summer Learning Programs for students currently in Year 2 Kindergarten or Grades 1, 2, or 3 during the summer of 2018.

The programs will run daily from July 2 to July 20, from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. (Monday to Friday).

- *The programs are designed to support students in the primary grades in maintaining their literacy and numeracy skills during the summer months.*

## Applying for the Program - Deadline is April 30, 2018

Children in Year 2 Kindergarten or Grades 1, 2, and 3 during the 2017-2018 school year are eligible to register for the Summer Learning programs. Children currently registered at any KPDSB school in the Dryden, Kenora, Ear Falls, or Red Lake areas will be considered for their respective programs.

Parents/guardians are asked to apply to the program for their child(ren) no later than **April 30, 2018**, either electronically or by filling out the application form on the back of this brochure. Acceptance into the program is based on students' needs, and is not on a first come, first served basis.

Parents/Guardians will be required to commit to the regular daily attendance of their child(ren), sign a permission form for their child to participate in the program, and provide transportation for their child daily (see the application form on the back of this brochure for further information). There is no fee for students to participate in the Summer Learning Programs, and free snacks and lunches will be provided daily.
